Monday	<p><u>Maths</u>: Check that you can count to 20 and back to 0 again.</p> <p><u>English</u>: <u>Reading</u>: Try to read every day. This can be a school reading book, a book of your choice from your collection at home or a comic. If you read an amazing book, send me an e-mail to tell me all about it or ask a grown up to take a photo of your work to send to me! <u>Phonics</u>: If you have a tablet, download the Teach Your Monster to Read App and the Monster Phonics App and work through some of the phonics games, daily. Please also keep working on spelling some of the high frequency words on the word card that we sent home too. <u>Writing</u>: Use the word card and your amazing phonic knowledge to write a diary extract each day to tell what you have been up to whilst you are learning from home! 😊</p> <p><u>Topic</u>: <u>Science</u>: Eat an apple and, when you get to the core, carefully remove the pips. Put some soil in to a yoghurt pot/ jam jar, dig a hole around an inch deep and plant some of the seeds. Water the plant well to encourage germination. Keep a close eye on your plant to see how quickly it starts to grow!</p>
Tuesday	<p><u>Maths</u>: Can you remember how to tell the time? Look at a clock/ watch and try to spot 'o'clock' times. Can you relate these to your daily routine? Tell me what you might do at different times eg 7 o'clock – wake up, 8 o'clock – breakfast ...</p> <p><u>English</u>: <u>Reading</u>: Try to read every day. This can be a school reading book, a book of your choice from your collection at home or a comic. If you read an amazing book, send me an e-mail to tell me all about it or ask a grown up to take a photo of your work to send to me! <u>Phonics</u>: If you have a tablet, download the Teach Your Monster to Read App and the Monster Phonics App and work through some of the phonics games, daily. Please also keep working on spelling some of the high frequency words on the word card that we sent home too. <u>Writing</u>: Use the word card and your amazing phonic knowledge to write a diary extract each day to tell what you have been up to whilst you are learning from home! 😊</p> <p><u>Topic</u>: <u>DT</u>: Taste lots of different types of salad vegetables before designing your own salad to make for tea. Which vegetables will you include? Chop up the vegetables carefully with a grown-ups help. (Don't forget to send me photos!)</p>
Wednesday	<p><u>Maths</u>: Practise your number formations by writing every number to 20. Ask a grown up to check that you are forming the numbers correctly.</p> <p><u>English</u>: <u>Reading</u>: Try to read every day. This can be a school reading book, a book of your choice from your collection at home or a comic. If you read an amazing book, send me an e-mail to tell me all about it or ask a grown up to take a photo of your work to send to me! <u>Phonics</u>: If you have a tablet, download the Teach Your Monster to Read App and the Monster Phonics App and work through some of the phonics games, daily. Please also keep working on spelling some of the high frequency words on the word card that we sent home too.</p>

<p>Thursday</p>	<p><u>Topic</u>: <u>RE</u>: Have a look at your Lent booklet and try to complete a few pages independently.</p> <p><u>Maths</u>: Roll a dice two times and add the numbers together. Repeat a few times.</p> <p><u>English</u>: <u>Reading</u>: Try to read every day. This can be a school reading book, a book of your choice from your collection at home or a comic. If you read an amazing book, send me an e-mail to tell me all about it or ask a grown up to take a photo of your work to send to me! <u>Phonics</u>: If you have a tablet, download the Teach Your Monster to Read App and the Monster Phonics App and work through some of the phonics games, daily. Eg 3+4=7</p> <p><u>English</u>: <u>Reading</u>: Try to read every day. This can be a school reading book, a book of your choice from your collection at home or a comic. If you read an amazing book, send me an e-mail to tell me all about it or ask a grown up to take a photo of your work to send to me! <u>Phonics</u>: If you have a tablet, download the Teach Your Monster to Read App and the Monster Phonics App and work through some of the phonics games, daily.
