Maths: My maths work set:

Challenge yourself on **TT Rockstars** – log in details found in your exercise book.

English: **Read:** school reading book or a comic or any favourite book at home

<u>Write:</u> Description – write a description of an unusual creature you have discovered in your garden, yard or in a field. Describe its:

<u>Appearance</u> – colour, skin, eyes, teeth, shape, size <u>Movement:</u> how it walks, runs, slithers? <u>Noise:</u> does it purr, squeak, hiss?

Name: what name have you given it? Is it friendly? Try to use **powerful verbs, adjectives, noun phrases.**

Spellings: Yr3/4 list: **peculiar, perhaps, popular**

Topic: RE – Doubting Thomas – google the story how Thomas didn't believe Jesus had risen until he saw him – "Happy are those who haven't seen and yet believe."

DRAW and write the story.

Maths: <u>Measures – Time</u> – using a timer on a mobile phone or Ipad Time in minutes and seconds:

The Time it takes to: 1) Run up and downstairs 3 times 2) To do 20 star jumps 3) To sing Happy Birthday 4) Touch your toes 15 times 5) To write out the 4 x tables Can you think of other activities to time?

Rapid recall of 4, 6 and 7 x tables

English: **Read:** school reading book or a comic or any favourite book at home

Write: Diary entry – in your exercise book – Purple Mash Blog – Class 2 page

English: **Read:** school reading book or a comic or any favourite book at home



Eg. Awake – awaken, awakened, awakening

Easier challenge – which words can you think of and spell ending in – ing and ed eg. running, laughing, singing, removed, helped ...

Spellings: Yr3/4 list: **position, possess, possession**

Topic: ART – DRAW The Risen Christ – google different images to draw and use of Colour
